



The 4th *Red Dot Art Mini Print Exhibition* will feature up to 500 mini prints from both traditional & contemporary fine art printmakers across the UK and mainland Europe.

The exhibition will tour England from September 2019 to May 2020. Participating galleries and specific exhibition dates will be made available on the Red Dot Art website when confirmed.

Eligibility

All professional and amateur printmakers are invited to submit work for this exciting exhibition.

Submission Deadline: Friday 30 August 2019.

Terms and conditions of entry

- Submissions are invited from artists working in any recognisable printmaking technique. Artists participating for the 1st time may submit up to two *different* prints. Returning artists may submit up to three *different* pieces.
- The print image must be contained within a square area of 10cm x 10cm or a rectangular area of 12.5cm x 7.5cm (landscape or portrait orientation) on a paper size of no larger than 15cm x 15cm. Please see the attached diagram
- **Submissions that do not meet this criteria will not be accepted.**
- All works will be prepared for exhibition by Red Dot Art Consultancy in a simple, core white mount measuring 20cm x 20cm and hung as deemed appropriate.
- All prints must be signed, numbered and titled by the artists, in pencil, beneath or within the image.
- All entries must be original and created within the last 2 years.
- The Red Dot Mini Print **Exhibition** is a selling exhibition and artists are advised that total of 40% commission will be retained by Red Dot Art (this includes any additional gallery commission) so please set your selling prices with this in mind.
- All payments for sales of pieces will be made by Red Dot Art to the artist within 2 weeks of payment being received from the purchaser.

Submission Timetable

- Prints for submission should be sent, lying flat, in a sturdy, reinforced envelope, with the correct postage to Lesley Jackson, Red Dot Art Consultancy, Manor Cottage, Syleham, Eye, Suffolk, IP21 4LP by **Friday 30 August 2019.**
- Red Dot Art Consultancy take full responsibility for the return packaging and postage of all unsold pieces.
- Each submitted piece must be accompanied by an official **submission form** or a piece of paper containing the following details;
 - Name of artist
 - Artist contact details with full postal address
 - Name of piece(s)
 - Printmaking technique(s)
 - Print edition number(s)
 - Selling price(s) – *please see above note*
- Entry fees, or details of payment if paid by BACS / Paypal (see below for details) must be included with the submission.
- Selected artists will be informed of inclusion in the exhibition by email by **Thursday 12 September 2019**
- Unsold pieces will be returned lying flat in packaging provided by Red Dot Art, to the artist following the exit of the exhibition from the final participating gallery in June 2020.

Entry Fees

- A non-refundable entry fee of **£45** per artist.
- Included in the entry fee is the cost of returning unsold work once the exhibition is over and the cost of transporting the exhibition to and from each of the participating galleries. Also included in the cost is the hire of all exhibition spaces, marketing and advertising, transport and insurance.

Alternatively, you can include a cheque, made payable to Lesley Jackson. Please do not send cash.

Editions

Please submit only one piece of each edition in the first instance. Once a piece has been sold, you will be contacted by Red Dot Art and asked to submit a replacement piece in time for the next exhibition.

Liability

Although all work will be handled, packaged and transported with maximum care, Red Dot Art and the participating galleries assume no responsibility for any damage or loss that may occur in transit to and from the galleries.

Publicity

All participating artists agree to their selected work being featured in on-line and off-line publicity and marketing materials accompanying and promoting the exhibition.
